



# The ABCs of God

## *A Study for Children on the Greatness and Worth of God*

The ABCs of God is a study for children on the greatness and worth of God. It uses the alphabet as a framework for learning the attributes of God and other terms that describe His character, at an age-appropriate level. (Note that attributes are purposely not taught in alphabetical order.) Through the use of a teaching aid called “The Blessing Box,” students will discover a new attribute of God each week and will be challenged to consider how they should respond to an amazing God who is worthy of their greatest love, honor, trust, and obedience.

### Lesson 1: **Questions**

*Memory Verse: Isaiah 46:9b*

The most important questions are: Who is God? What is God like? How should I act toward God? The Bible gives us the true answers to the most important questions.

### Lesson 2: **Incomprehensible**

*Memory Verse: Job 37:5*

God is more than we can fully understand.

---

### Lesson 3: **YHWH (Yahweh)**

*Memory Verses: Isaiah 42:8a and Psalm 9:10a*

Yahweh is God’s personal name. God desires to make His name known.

### Lesson 4: **Eternal**

*Memory Verse: Psalm 90:2*

God has no beginning or end.

### Lesson 5: **Creator**

*Memory Verse: Isaiah 44:24b*

God made everything.

### Lesson 6: **Glorious**

*Memory Verses: Psalm 19:1 and Psalm 72:19a*

God shows His greatness and worth.

### Lesson 7: **Wise**

*Memory Verse: Psalm 104:24a*

God causes everything to work out perfectly.

### Lesson 8: **Almighty**

*Memory Verse: Jeremiah 32:17*

God is all-powerful.

---

### Lesson 9: **Sovereign**

*Memory Verse: Psalm 115:3*

God has the right and wisdom and power to do all He pleases.

Lesson 10: **Provider***Memory Verse: Acts 17:25b*

God meets the needs of His creation.

Lesson 11: **Self-Sufficient***Memory Verse: Acts 17:25*

God does not need anything.

Lesson 12: **Understanding***Memory Verses: Psalm 103:13-14*

God remembers that we are weak.

Lesson 13: **Attentive***Memory Verse: Psalm 34:15*

God constantly sees, hears, and acts in the world.

Lesson 14: **Faithful***Memory Verse: 1 Thessalonians 5:24*

God always does what He says He will do.

Lesson 15: **Trinity***Memory Verses: Deuteronomy 6:4 and Matthew 28:19*

God is three persons in one God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Lesson 16: **Happy***Memory Verse: 1 Timothy 6:15b*

God delights in being God.

Lesson 17: **Love***Memory Verse: John 3:16*

God gives of Himself for the joy of others.

Lesson 18: **Omnipresent***Memory Verse: Jeremiah 23:24*

God is everywhere all the time.

Lesson 19: **Refuge***Memory Verses: Proverbs 18:10 and Psalm 46:1*

God is a place of safety for His people.

Lesson 20: **Unchanging***Memory Verses: Malachi 3:6a; Hebrews 13:8*

God never changes.

Lesson 21: **Omniscient***Memory Verse: 1 John 3:20b*

God knows everything.

Lesson 22: **Good***Memory Verse: Psalm 145:9*

God is good in all He is and does.

Lesson 23: **Jealous***Memory Verses: Isaiah 42:8 and Exodus 34:14*

God will not share His glory, or the honor and praise He deserves.

Lesson 24: **Righteous***Memory Verse: Psalm 119:137*

Everything that God thinks, says, and does is right.

Lesson 25: **Wrathful***Memory Verse: Romans 1:18a*

God is very angry at sin, and is right to punish sinners.

Lesson 26: **Patient***Memory Verse: 2 Peter 3:9*

God is slow to anger and slow to punish.

Lesson 27: **Merciful***Memory Verse: Psalm 145:8*

God is kind to undeserving sinners.

Lesson 28: **Zealous***Memory Verse: Isaiah 42:13*

God acts with His whole heart.

Lesson 29: **Deliverer***Memory Verse: 1 Timothy 1:15a*

God saves His sinful people from the punishment they deserve.

Lesson 30: **Victorious***Memory Verse: 1 Chronicles 29:11a*

God always wins, even over Satan, sin, and death.

Lesson 31: **King***Memory Verses: Psalm 47:7a, 8*

God rules over everyone.

Lesson 32: **eXalted***Memory Verse: Psalm 97:9*

God ranks far above everything else. He is the Most High.

Lesson 33: **Holy***Memory Verse: Isaiah 40:25*

God is like nothing else. He is perfect and is separate from sin.

Lesson 34: **Worthy***Memory Verse: Philippians 3:8a*

God is most valuable and deserves our greatest love, obedience, and worship.

Lesson 35: **Bountiful***Memory Verse: Psalm 13:6*

God is more than enough to satisfy all our desires.

Lesson 36: **Never-Tiring***Memory Verses: Isaiah 40:28b and Psalm 121:3b*

God never gets tired and never sleeps.

Lesson 37: **Seeking God***Memory Verses: Jeremiah 29:13 and Romans 10:13*

Seeking God means experiencing a desperate need for God's forgiveness and calling out to Jesus to save you.

Lesson 38: **Loving God***Memory Verse: Psalm 73:25*

Loving God is knowing, feeling, and treating God as your greatest treasure.

Lesson 39: **Trusting and Obeying God***Memory Verse: John 10:27*

Trusting and obeying God means following and obeying God because you know Him to be trustworthy.

Lesson 40: **Enjoying God***Memory Verse: Psalm 16:11*

Those who trust in Jesus can experience the great and lasting joy of being God's children and enjoying Him forever.
