



The Call of God

Scope & Sequence

The Call of God is an evangelistic study for children on the work of God in redemption. The goal of this curriculum is not to lead a child to “accept Jesus” or to pray a conversion prayer. In contrast, the goal of the curriculum is two-fold: To help children understand 1) that God is calling people to Himself; and 2) that this world is not the only world there is; there is also a spiritual world and what happens in that world is what really counts. The five lessons in this curriculum explore the call of God and responses to that call.
