



## Lord, Teach Us to Pray

### Scope & Sequence

*Lord, Teach Us to Pray* is an intergenerational study for children and adults on prayer. The curriculum uses *The Lord's Prayer* as a framework for teaching about prayer, because it is what Jesus used when His disciples requested that He teach them how to pray. In so doing, Jesus showed them what should be in the believer's heart when he comes to God in prayer. *Lord, Teach Us to Pray* is not about a correct formula for prayer—it is about God's children learning to fellowship with Him in prayer. Each week the class will add visuals to a large scrapbook that is completed in the final lesson. (Students will also be able to

make their own smaller versions of this scrapbook.) *The Family Devotional Guide* enables families to build on each lesson at home through daily family devotions throughout the week.
