What You Need to Start

Jesus, What a Savior! is written to be taught to lower elementary students over 40 weeks in a Sunday school setting. The two main components of class time are the lesson—20-30 minutes, and the application time—15-30 minutes. Directions for adapting the curriculum to different time frames or settings, such as a private school or in the home, are included. The main teacher or team leader for the class should begin with a Classroom Kit as well as a Student Workbook for each student attending the class.

A. Teacher's Guide

Contains curriculum introduction with teaching instructions, 40 lessons, and an appendix with further teacher resources.

B. Student Workbook

Workbooks help children apply lesson truths to their own heart. Includes lesson overview, memory verse/s, and an activity such as coloring, cutting and pasting, tracing letters, or matching.

Print Format: printed in black and white and spiral bound.

C. Resources DVD

Includes Visuals for Electronic display and printable PDFs of the Visual Packet, Growing in Faith Together pages, Application Resources, Optional Activity Handouts, Verse Cards, and the curriculum logo.

D. Verse Cards

Pocket-sized cards are used to encourage Bible memorization. Features the memory verse for each lesson along with several key themes and definitions from the curriculum.


Print Format: printed in black and white on heavy cardstock and bound with a metal ring.

Student Workbook





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Additional Resources

Depending on the size and structure of your children's ministry program, as well as the teaching styles of the ministry team, you may need additional resources in order to accommodate co-teachers and small group leaders, or to better equip your students to memorize Scripture. The resources listed below are recommended based on these and other variable factors.

Teacher's Guide

ORDER ONE FOR EACH **ADDITIONAL** TEACHER OR SMALL GROUP LEADER (AVAILABLE IN PRINT OR ELECTRONIC FORMATS)

A. Each co-teacher, small group leader, and team leader should have their own copy of the curriculum to study and pray through as they prepare to minister to the children under their care. The Teacher's Guide (which is also available in the Classroom Kit) contains the curriculum introduction with teaching instructions, 40 lessons, and an appendix with further teacher resources.

Print Format: choose from a 3-ring binder or spiral bound.

Visuals Packet

ORDER ONE IF YOU WOULD LIKE PRINTED VISUALS

B. Visuals help capture and retain student attention during the lesson and demonstrate more complicated concepts. The Visuals Packet contains a full printed set (167 pages) of the lesson visuals. (The visuals are also available as PDF files on the Resources DVD in the Classroom Kit, if you prefer to print them yourself or display them electronically.)

Print Format: printed in full color on 8.5 by 11 inch heavy cardstock.

C. The Growing in Faith Together: Parent and Child Resource Pages are packaged together to be given to parents at the beginning of the year. This saves administrative time for the church staff and/or teacher and provides parents with a valuable tool for discussing the lessons and facilitating review.

D. Verse cards provide a handy tool for students to use to memorize the verses that correspond to the truths they are learning each week.
